Reference is invited to Bureau's circular dated 28th July 2000 regarding enrolment of new editions and/or printing centres of existing editions to Bureau membership.

Under the present procedure, starting of any new edition and/or a printing centre of an existing edition during an audit period is considered for enrolment to Bureau membership from the date of starting an edition and/or printing centre, irrespective of the fact whether the new edition and/or printing centre had published and printed the publication during the entire six monthly audit period i.e. January/June or July/December (as the case may be).

In case of single centre publication, application for Bureau membership from a prospecting member is considered only if a publication was printed and published during an entire audit period of six months. In order to rationalise the rule, Council at its recent meeting decided that in case of multicentre publication availing a combined certificate, starting of a new edition will be considered for enrolment to Bureau membership and subsequent certification only if it has **completed a full audit period of six months** i.e. either Janauary/June or July/December (as the case may be). Starting of a new printing centre of an existing edition will however continue to be considered for enrolment/certification for part audit period.

The above procedure is effective from the audit period July/December 2001.

On the subject, Council considered and adopted following definitions for an edition & a printing centre:

	A publication/title separately registered with Registrar of Newspapers for India (RNI) and having a separate registration number, serial No. & Volume Number.
"Printing Centre":	Printing of an edition of a publication carried out simultaneously at any other location with same RNI registration number and volume number.
